



PROTEST RACIST, SEXIST, ANTI-GAY ATTACKS!

STOP KKK TERROR!!

TIMOTHY LEE, 23

Timothy Lee, a 23 year old black gay man, was found dead, hung from a tree near the Concord BART station, on Saturday, November 2, 1985. His body was found just two miles from the place where Tony Lamar Hall and Jeffrey Charles Miller, two young black men, were stabbed on the same night, by two white men in KKK robes.

The Concord police closed the investigation, claiming that Timothy Lee committed suicide. But the "suicide note" misspelled Timothy's name and the names of family members. Even though the strap used in the lynching didn't belong to Tim, the coroner's office destroyed the evidence.

This was no "suicide." Timothy Lee was a successful fashion design student who had just won a fellowship to study in Milan, Italy. He was also half Native American. He and his mother had participated in the Alcatraz occupations of the early 70's.

Timothy Lee's family went to the press to expose the Concord police's coverup, and also went to the NAACP. The Coalition Against Racist, Sexist, Anti-Gay Attacks (CARSAGA) formed to protest this racist, anti-gay lynching. The Coalition held two demonstrations, one in November and one in December, to expose the police cover-up. The Coalition demanded a full, independent investigation controlled by workers, blacks, other people of color, and lesbians and gays. The Coalition also held a community meeting to discuss the case, as well as other KKK attacks.

On January 3, 1986, the NAACP held a press conference, calling for an FBI investigation of Timothy Lee's death. On January 7 the FBI announced that they had opened an investigation. Recently, witnesses have reported that they heard screams near the BART station around the time of Timothy Lee's murder. Timothy Lee's family has filed a \$2 million suit against BART. Tony Hall and Jeffrey Miller have also filed suit for violation of their civil rights. Their KKK attackers have been arrested. One pleaded guilty; the other, Harrold Gallant, is going to trial on Monday, March 3, at 10:00 am, at the Martinez Courthouse. The Coalition is calling a demonstration at 9:00 am at the Courthouse, to protest this racist, KKK attack.

The Coalition meets weekly on Tuesdays at 7:30 pm, at the New College of Law, 50 Fell Street at Van Ness Avenue, in San Francisco, to plan further actions. We want to find out who killed Timothy Lee, and to expose the Klan and Nazi organizing and attacks that have been on the rise in Contra Costa County, around the Bay area, and throughout the country. Community response, pressure and actions can help stop these attacks.

The police will not protect us. They are covering up Timothy Lee's murder. It's important for black, gay, Jewish, lesbian, immigrant, feminist, labor, leftist, Chicano, Latino, Arab American, Asian American, Native American, disabled, and all people who are targets of Klan and Nazi terror, to organize together to defend ourselves, our organizations, and our communities. We must show the KKK and the Nazis that we will not be terrorized by their hatred and attacks.
